Write a HTML file for a web page that contains the items below. Use an internal style sheet (i.e., a style block) to specify all fonts, sizes, colors, and any other aspects of presentation. Submit your HTML file to the Homework 21 assignment on Moodle.

Your page should contain:

- A header with white text on a dark green background, in Arial font, bold, and centered.
- Two paragraphs of text, each with dark gray text in Tahoma font, on a light blue background, with a dark blue border.
- At least two hyperlinks, with the default link color set to something other than blue.
- An unordered (bulleted) list, with square bullets and left margin set to 100 pixels.
- At least three other items and styles that you want to include. Experiment and have fun!

After creating your page, use the <u>HTML 5 Validator</u> to check that you have written valid HTML.

For help with HTML tags, see <u>this HTML tutorial</u>. For help with CSS selectors and properties, see <u>this CSS tutorial</u>. For help with colors, see the <u>HTML Color Picker</u>.

You can create your web page in a text editor (such as Sublime, Spyder, Idle, TextEdit, or Notepad). You may wish to create the web page using the W3Schools "Try It" editor and then save it as an HTML file. In any case, make sure to save your file with a .html extension and open it in a web browser to view the page that you created.
